

HOW TO USE: BLEND TOOL

From now on i will be showing you how to use some tools,in depth, to create fun projects.

Today i'll show you one of my favourite tools: **blend tool**.

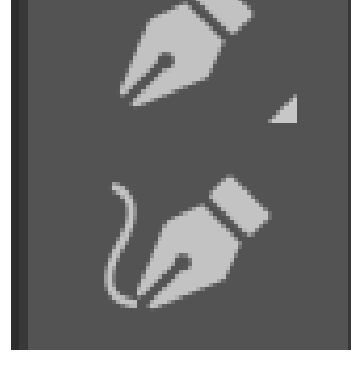


This is what it looks like.

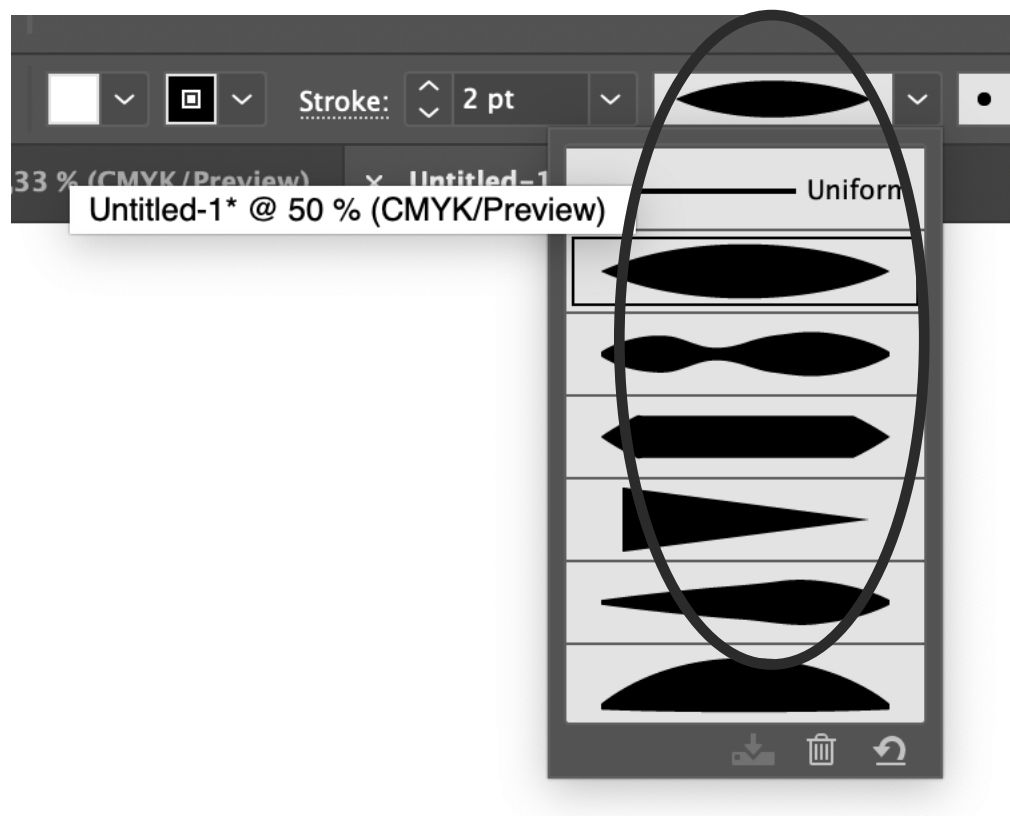
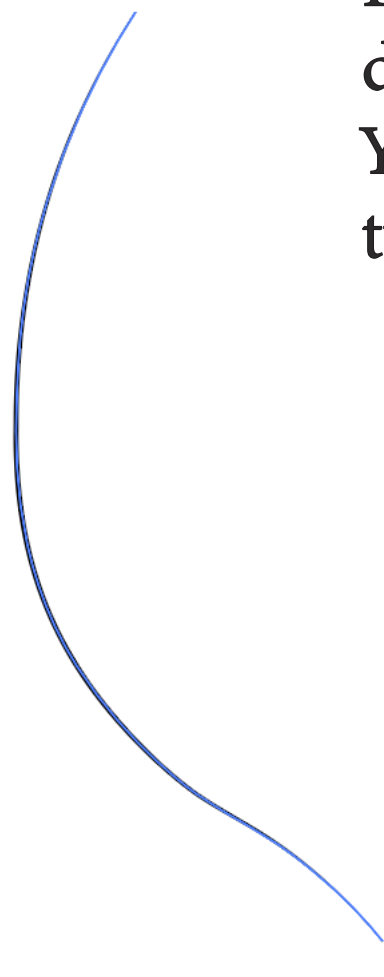
A few examples of what you can make:



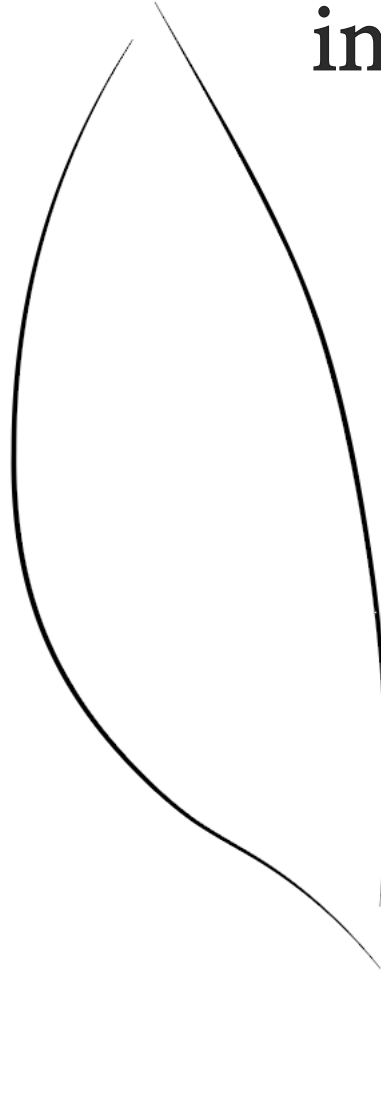
STEP 1: Click on one of the pen options,then draw a curve.



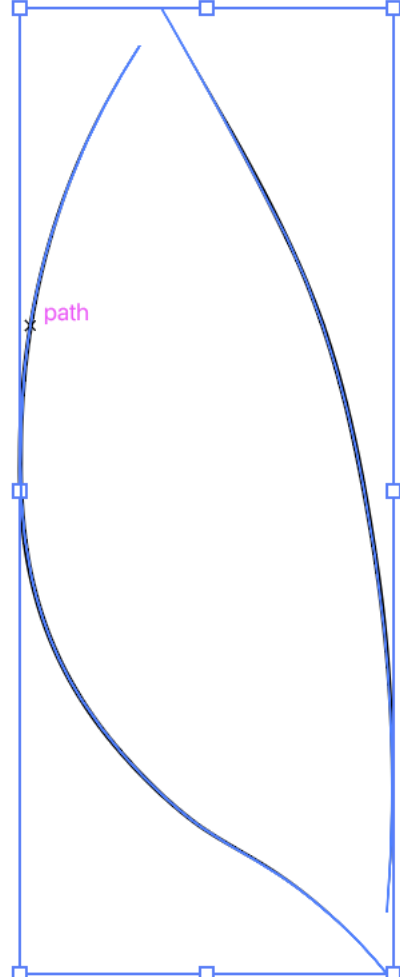
I used the second pen, drawing a curvy line. You can change the type of pen at the top menu.



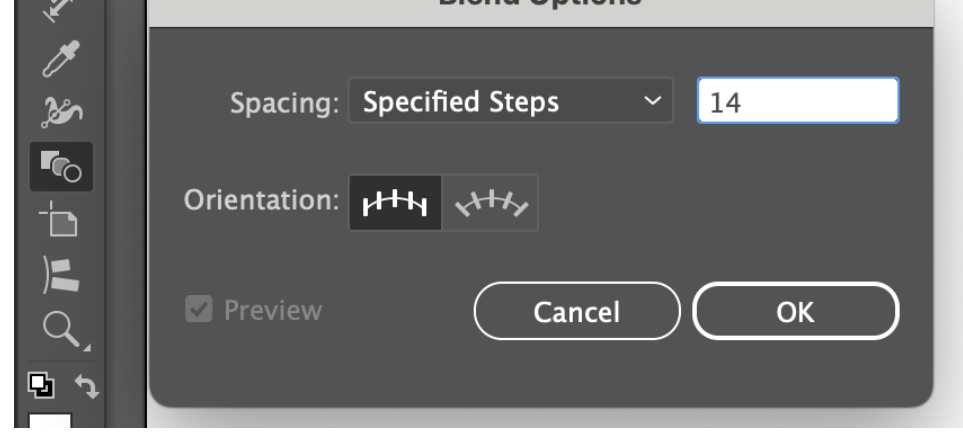
STEP 2: Draw another line,i am drawing a petal. What i'm doing here is drawing the out lines,keeping it simple and leaving gaps in the corners.



STEP 3: Drag ur mouse over the screen,selecting both of the lines. (Or select one line and press ALT+CTRL while selecting the other line!)

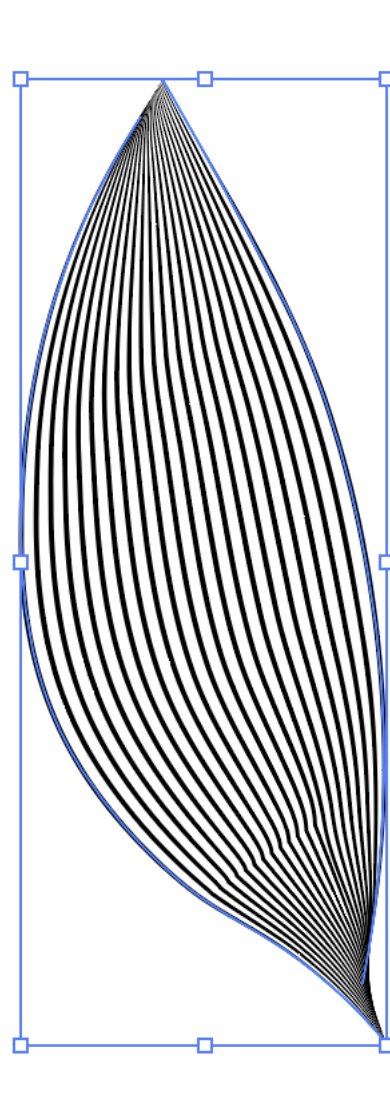


STEP 4: Double click on the blend tool,choose "specified" steps.

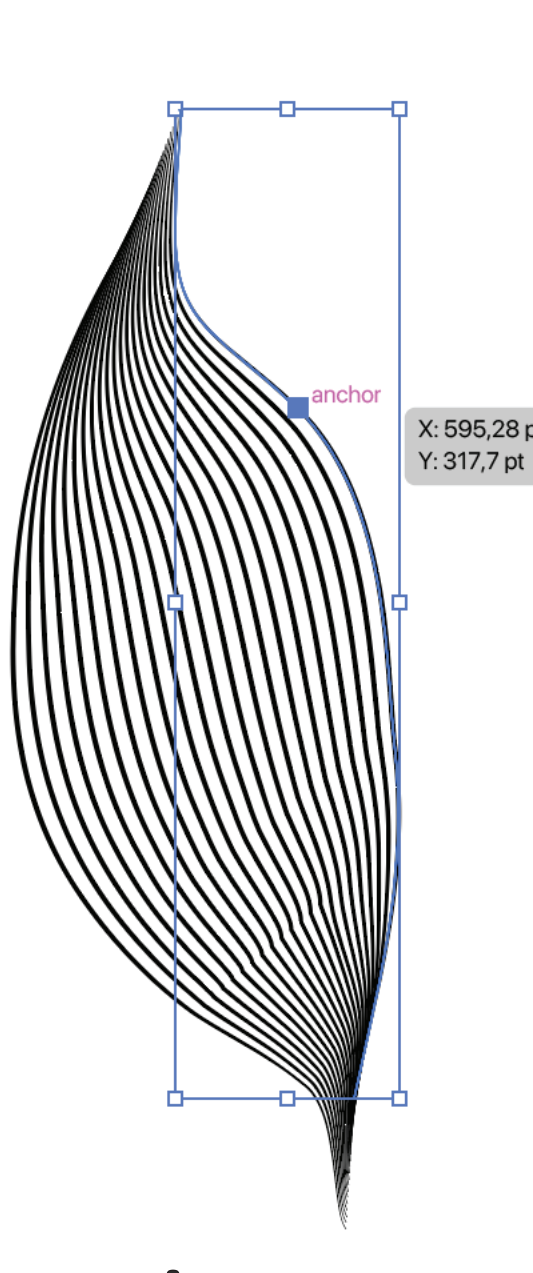


Choose any number you want, it equals to the amounts of lines that will appear inside the gap of the petal (if you don't like the result,press CTRL+Z to undo, modify the setting and try again!).

STEP 5: While you're on the blend tool,click on both of the lines,and here you go:



you can adjust everything to your liking (curve,points, the ends) , using the white arrow.



There you go!

It could take a while to get used to it sometimes you might have to make different attempts to get the result you want,but once you do,you can make some really cool projects. Goodbye,everybody!
